Stream Protocols

All should be aware that we are in the Corporate Presence of God despite being in your home physically.

Guidelines for Logging In

A Zoom gathering invitation will be sent via email to designated persons in each household inviting them to join our online gathering which will look like this:

Join Zoom Meeting

NOTE: No member is authorized to give remote access to the online corporate gathering to any non-member of the community without proper authorization.

The Zoom Meeting ID # must never be given out to anyone who is not a member of IIC without the clear consent of eldership or those authorized.



Attire and Appearance

Dress appropriately as if coming to a meeting at the Kingdom Community Facility.

Everyone needs to be appropriately attired as you will be visible to everyone else while streaming. (No bare back or vest)

Although you are in your own home, you are in fact attending a corporate gathering of the community.

Seating Format

Adherence to the format for sitting is very important for proper capture.

Ensure that only your upper torso (upper body) is visible in the video frame.

In the case of a family your Seating should be of such where the camera captures

everyone. One screen should accommodate all persons in the same room.



Seating Location

The location chosen to sit in the house must be strategically determined beforehand.

Backdrop

As much as is possible, locate yourself where there is a neutral background that is not distracting in any way e.g. Plain wall, curtain or blind.

Background Noise

Ensure that there is no or minimal background noise where you are located in the house. Headphones can be used to help cancel out background noise where there is one person with one device.

Room Lighting

Ensure the lighting in the room allows you to be clearly seen but is not blinding or distracting to others.

Logging in

All members are to be logged into the stream 20 minutes before the start time of the meeting to facilitate the testing of audio & video systems.

If for any reason, you are unable to log into the stream for the designated time, you must ensure that someone can account for you.

Where technical support is required, contact your GCT team.

Try to avoid multiple log-ins from within one home as connections may be limited as well as more connections can slow the internet in the home.

While Online

Unless otherwise instructed, ensure that your camera is turned on so that you are visible to the presenter and other participants.

Ensure that your audio (mic) is off at all times and is only put on if making a comment.

Ensure that your name or family name is clearly stated to identify you. (Eg. Mario Granger, Haynes Family).

Personal Conduct/Meeting Etiquette


Be mindful that you are actually attending a Corporate Gathering of the community.


There must be no lying down or the performing of household tasks and activities while the meeting is in progress. You want to be alert, undistracted and fully engaged during the meeting.

There should be no eating or drinking during the meeting just as it would be in our physical church gatherings.

Minimize your movement so as not to cause a distraction to the presenter and other participants.

If there is a situation that you have to attend to while the meeting is in progress, stop your video, attend to your emergency and return quickly to reactivate your video

Be aware of comments, movements and gesticulations being made while online.

You will be visible to other participants streaming into the meeting and want to avoid unwittingly causing a distraction.

E.g. scolding a child, talking to someone, making some noticeable movement frequently.

Confidentiality

Be sensitive to who is in your space e.g. unsaved persons sharing the same space with you.

If you do not live alone, then be strategic where you sit in the house when streaming especially when members of your household are not all members of the IIC (Headphones can be used in a situation like this).

Be mindful that the KC is a private organization and an online environment does not change that reality.

Invitation To Non-Members

If you wish to invite someone to be a part of the meeting (in your home) who is not a member, prior notification must be given so that proper protocols can be followed.

E.g. welcoming them to the meeting.
